

NOTCH CODES

LARGE FORMAT SHEET FILM

Notch Codes are indentations on the edge of a sheet of film that are used to identify the orientation and type of film you are using. This is particularly useful when operating in the dark as it allows you to identify, by touch, the emulsion side of the film when loading it into a film holder. In portrait orientation, the notches will appear on the top right edge of the sheet with the emulsion facing you. The notches are also useful for labs so they know how to process the film.

ILFORD sheet film has 2 patterns for each product. Sizes up to and including 10x12" are shown below left and sizes larger than 10x12" below right.
